*Suzanna Pejaska's painting resembles the artist: an elaborated modern architecture offering the observer, on the smooth surfaces of elegant and solid background in cold or dark tones, composed as a contemporary abstraction, the gripping contrast of the meticulous representation of a piece of foreign cloth laid down there, simply - a construction of links and multicolored gems whose vividness, relief, precious details, bright, sparkling and refined colors associate with the conception of the whole of the picture in introducing a manner of painting in depth - suggesting secrecy, personal life and the warmth of an intimacy that is not revealed. Respect for the materials, without overlay, a frankly pictorial representation whose dreaming aloofness avoids any heaviness and introduces us directly to the heart of the human, in front of this fire that burns quietly before our eyes, somewhere in the vast space of the exterior world. Beautiful art - skillful, sober, sensitive - that immediately seduces the eye, the spirit and the imagination.*
